

Petition to be Incorporated.

GEORGIA—Fayette County:

To the Superior Court of Said County:

The petition of J T Lewis, R P Minter, E J Snead, E G Luncford, James Sams, E M Roberts, D T Wilder, J R Rivers, A J Dunn, R M Weatherly, Lewis & Matthews, Dr. G O Gunter, W J Sams, C R Woolsey, Jonie Woolsey, L E Peoples, I H Peoples, I G Woolsey, W T Dunn, W B Snead, all of said County, A J Wilder, J M Rivers, H T Rivers, I D Crawford, E B Holt, of Clayton county and A O Gay, of Spalding county, all of said parties being residents of Said State shows:

1st That they desire for themselves, their associates, successors and assignes, to be incorporated under the name and style of the Woolsey Gin and Warehouse Co.

2nd The term for which petitioners ask to be incorporated is twenty (20) years with the privilege of renewal at that time.

3rd The Capital Stock of said company is to be \$6,000.00. To be divided into shares of Fifty (\$50) Dollars each. Petitioners ask for the privilege of increasing said stock to the amount of Twenty (20) Thousand Dollars.

4th Two Thousand Dollars of said capital stock has actually been paid in.

5th The object of said proposed corporation is for pecuniary gain to stockholders.

6th Petitioners propose to carry on a general Gin and Warehouse business as follows, ginning cotton, storing, selling, grading and weighing cotton, storing and handling fertilizers and manufacturing farm impliments, cotton seed meal and hulls etc.
